  assessments in mid-May. Thereafter, parents of these pupils will
  be invited to consultation afternoons/evenings to learn of pupils'
  individual results in the assessments and of their progress over the
  academic year.
- The parents of Reception/Foundation Stage pupils will be invited to individual consultations with Mrs Pockett, later this term, to discuss respective pupil progress.
- Pupils' Annual Reports to Parents will be sent home at the beginning of July, together with the school's annual questionnaire on 'Parents' Evaluations of the Academic Year' and a copy of the 'Y6 Pupils Report to Parents & Governors'.
