Normally, school does not have these formal opportunities in the Spring term but, because of the changes above, we thought these individual sessions, later in the Spring term, would be welcomed by all concerned as invaluable in enabling all pupils' ongoing progress to be considered and evaluated.

• TOPICS

This term, pupils in Y5 & Y6 are studying 'REACHING FOR THE PEAKS', pupils in Y3 & Y4 are studying 'MAGNIFICENT METALS' and infant pupils are learning all about 'CHANGE DETECTIVES' and 'IMPORTANT PEOPLE'.

• 'GOVERNORS IN SCHOOL' FOCUS:

Governors will be in school throughout this Spring term, formally observing and monitoring again according to the *priorities* identified in the school's Improvement Plans 2017-2018. They will be talking to pupils and staff, studying pupils' work and reporting back to the FGB on their findings. Governors will continue to *evaluate* the school's Collective Worship, Assemblies and RE lessons as part of their impact on the school's distinctive Christian character.
