Dear Parents, Carers & Pupils

We hope families enjoyed their Easter holiday, which was tinged with some sadness for all associated with the school with the demise of Mrs Harwell's mother on Good Friday. The condolences of everyone have been sent to the Harwell family.

In spite of it being one of the shortest and coldest of Spring terms on record, it was also one of the most exciting professionally with teachers teaching in different year groups, attending a variety of courses in preparation for future testing and assessing arrangements and the formal monitoring and reporting of the school's practices in 'Teaching & Learning' (and 'Inclusion') by the local Education Authority, together with their respective in-depth analysis and evaluation of 'Pupil Performance & Progress', leading happily to the affirmation of the school's 'outstanding' judgement.

The cold weather conditions presented many logistical challenges for the leadership and management of the school too, with closure on Friday 2nd March and events like the Chess Tournament against Lancing Prep. School, Hove **and** the Y5 'Choral Day' at Christs Hospital being cancelled because no possible alternative date/s could be found and some events, like the Y6 'Bikeability Assessment Week' being rescheduled to another week AND another venue!

The school's termly 'Y5&6 Cookery Day' at Shoreham College had to be postponed - not as a result of weather conditions this time but due to teacher, Mrs Young, sustaining an injury to her shoulder! It is now due to take place this term.

Even with such ups and downs, the Spring term turned out to be an enjoyable one with lunchtime football on the field, almost daily, and wins in Chess against Windlesham School, in Football against Coldwaltham and Amberley Schools and in Netball against other competitors in The

Towers' Netball Tournament for Y4-6 Girls. It even ended on the last day of term with an Ashurst 'first', a 'GRAND WHOLE SCHOOL INDOOR SKIP' for 'SPORTS RELIEF'!
