Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things.

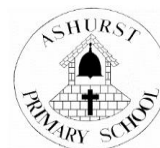
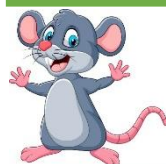
What makes every single person unique and precious?

Maths

Use number names and symbols when comparing numbers, showing interest in large numbers.
Increasingly confident at putting numerals in order 0 to 10 (ordinality).
Enjoy reciting numbers from 0 to 10 (and beyond) and back from 10 to 0.
Begin to explore and work out mathematical problems, using signs and strategies of their own choice, including (when appropriate) standard numerals, tallies and "+" or "-".
Estimate of numbers of things, showing understanding of relative size.

Physical

Develop the overall body strength, coordination, balance and agility needed to engage successfully with future physical education sessions and other physical disciplines including dance and sport.

Develop the foundations of a handwriting style which is fast, accurate and efficient.

Expressive Arts and Design

Draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details.
