- Pupils in **Y1**, **Y3**, **Y4** & **Y5** will be undertaking their *in-school* assessments in mid-May too. Thereafter, parents of these pupils will be invited to consultation afternoons/evenings to learn of pupils' individual results in these assessments and of their progress *over* the academic year.
- The parents of **Reception/Foundation Stage** pupils will be invited to **individual consultations** with Mrs Pockett, later this term, to discuss respective pupil progress.
- **Pupils' Annual Reports to Parents** will be sent home at the beginning of July, together with the school's annual questionnaire on 'Parents' Evaluations of the Academic Year' plus a copy of the 'Y6 Pupils' Annual Report to Parents & Governors'.
