TEACHING & LEARNING ARRANGEMENTS this term:

The school's overall responsibility for FS/KS1 rests with MRS POCKETT, Y3&4 + whole school RE & ART with MRS SMITH, Y5&6 + whole school PE/Games with MRS SANSBURY and whole school COMPUTING with MRS HEDLEY. MRS WILLIAMS has overall responsibility for the CURRICULUM and ASSESSMENT.

As a result of the very positive feed-back school received from parents, pupils and staff on the teaching and learning arrangements for *part* mornings of Spring term 2018, the school is looking forward to retaining much the same for this Spring term.

PE/GAMES PROGRAMME: SPECIALIST HORSHAM LEISURELINK TEACHER MRS JAGOTA will be supporting the school's weekly PE/Games programme, SPECIALIST SWIMMIMG TEACHER MISS MILES will be supporting the school's weekly SWIMMING programme and SPECIALIST GYMNASTICS COACH MRS WADMAN will be supporting the school's GYMNASTIC programme for all pupils this SPRING TERM.....all overseen by the school's PE/GAMES teacher, MRS SANSBURY.

FRENCH: With the resignation due to ill-health of Mrs Scadding-Hunt at the end of the Autumn term, KS2 class teachers will be responsible for teaching MFL FRENCH to their own classes at the start of the Spring term. We thank Mrs Scadding-Hunt for her outstanding contribution to French lessons at APS and wish her a full and speedy recovery - and maybe a return to APS before long, we hope so!

PARENT CONSULTATION EVENINGS: TUESDAY 26TH FEBRUARY and THURSDAY 28TH FEBRUARY. The school does not normally have these formal opportunities in the Spring term but, because of the above arrangements, we thought these individual sessions later in the Spring term, would be a welcome opportunity to meet and discuss pupils' on-going progress with teachers.

• SAFEGUARDING, PUPIL WELFARE & WELL-BEING

School has booked representatives from the NSPCC to visit the school on FRIDAY 1^{ST} FEBRUARY to undertake a special *age-related* programme on 'Pupil Safety', including use of the internet, to all pupils across the school, and has booked representatives from the LA to meet with pupils and staff on the same this term.

• 'CITIZENSHIP' Y5

The school's annual Y5 Citizenship Course in Horsham, including Safety & Well-Being, is booked for the second half of the Spring term with more details to respective families nearer the time.

'GOVERNORS IN SCHOOL' FOCUS:

The school welcomes governors formally in school throughout this Spring term, observing and monitoring according to the *priorities* identified in the school's Improvement Plans 2018-2019 e.g Safeguarding, School Funding and School Performance, and against an additional school 'Action Plan' set in place in the Autumn term focussing on early phonological awareness and maths across the school, principally: proportion, fractions and ratio. Governors will be talking to pupils and staff, studying pupils' work and reporting back to the FGB on their findings.

Annually, these are held for the parents of each class in the Spring term but, due to the above arrangements we look forward to inviting parents to respective 'SHARING ASSEMBLIES', based on topics this term, in the SUMMER TERM.
