#### ASSESSMENT and REPORTING ON PUPIL PROGRESS TO PARENTS:

- Y6 pupils will be undertaking their end of KS2 SAT formal assessments from 13th-16<sup>th</sup> May.
- Pupils in Y3, Y4 & Y5 will be undertaking in-school assessments during the same week. Thereafter, parents of these pupils will be invited to consultation afternoons/evenings to learn of pupils' individual results in these assessments and of their progress over the academic year.
- Y2 pupils will be undertaking their end of KS1 SAT formal assessments during May
- Y1 pupils and Y2 reviews will be undertaking assessments in Phonics in early in June.
- The parents of Reception/Foundation Stage pupils will be invited to individual consultations with Mrs Pockett, later this term, to discuss respective pupil progress in the 'Early Learning Goals.
- Pupils' Annual Reports to Parents will be sent home at the beginning of July, together with the school's annual questionnaire on 'Parents' Evaluations of the Academic Year' plus a copy of the 'Y6 Pupils' Annual Report to Parents & Governors'.
