We are fast approaching the end of term and I wanted to share with you some of the wonderful activities both the children and staff have been involved in so far, and also have planned for the rest of this half term.



Song for Archie Year 5/6 children took part in a locality "Song for Archie" afternoon led by Emily Barden from West Sussex Music. This was a very moving and successful event for everyone involved. Children from a variety of schools across West Sussex took part to create a beautiful composition which represents a musical gift for Archie, the son of the Duke and Duchess of Sussex. We are hopeful this will be released before Christmas.

Great Fire of London The children in Mrs Clarke's class have been busy making model houses for their "Great Fire of London scene" and they have all been enjoying learning about how to keep themselves safe in the event of a fire and what to do in an emergency. FAPs provided a variety of lovely new books to support Mrs Clarke and Miss Kelsey in helping the children with their phonics and reading. The children are extremely excited to have brand new books to read.

The Mayan Civilisation Year 3/4 have been busy studying the Maya civilisation and have created some wonderful masks and weaving, which are on display for you to see you in their classroom. They have also thoroughly enjoyed learning to play the ocarina – a highlight of the term for them!

Remembrance Assembly This year's Remembrance assembly was led by the children in Year 3/4,

who did a very moving performance about evacuation from a child's perspective. This was followed by our visitors talking about their own experiences, which prompted some very insightful comments from the

children. Our school flutists also played beautifully and Mr Timms performed 'The Last Post' on the Bugle, making the event even more poignant. The





children are now looking forward to performing in the 'Christmas Celebration', eagerly rehearsing the singing with Mrs Harwell.

Ancient Greeks Year 5/6 have been busy learning about the Ancient Greeks and finding out all about Homer and the Iliad. They have created some amazing paper mâché masks and I am reliably informed this was a messy but fun activity.

Year 6 Boosters The Year 6 children have started their booster sessions with Mrs Sansbury and are enjoying the opportunity to work in a small group, as well as have their own new books to work from!

Christmas Performances

All the children are looking forward to celebrating Christmas at Ashurst with a number of special events coming up. Our younger children are busy rehearsing for their performance, '**The Nativity**', which will be performed to parents on **Thursday 12**th **December at 9:15am.**
