If your child has suddenly been asked to self-isolate and is not actually ill, we realise that this is a difficult and uncertain time and you need something structured to support you with your child's learning. This year one of our school's development areas has been to develop our remote learning provision. We will be using Google Classrooms where the situation involves whole group 'bubbles', or indeed whole school closure due to Covid-19 restrictions, together with a range of online learning resources. In the interim please can we ask that your child completes their year group learning activities using the Oak Academy site for Maths, English and a Foundation subject. This is now a much-improved site and in line with year group expectations.

Select your child's year group, or choose up a year or down a year, as appropriate to their learning stage.

This then takes you to the current week and day of the week and presents you with three lessons to interact with online. Please provide your child with a device to watch this with, some paper, pencil and ruler.

Your child can also still log on to Purple Mash where there are a range of excellent resources, together with TT Rock Stars for maths and tables revision.

We also ask that you read with them (ideally 20 minutes a day.)

Obviously if your child is ill or becomes ill, we do not expect them to be working.

Please email any specific issues via School Office for attention of the class teacher. Ashurst Primary School respects the privacy and work/life balance of its staff and we do not expect our staff to check or respond to emails when they are not at work, weekends or during holidays. Teaching staff will prioritise teaching activities and we cannot guarantee your email will be read the same day you send it. Office emails will be monitored on working days where possible, and if received after 16:00 will most likely be processed the following working day. We will always do our best to support you where we can.
