What did the Romans do for us?

This term, our topic will involve finding out about 'What the Romans did for us'. We will be researching what life was like in Roman times and the legacies that still continue, for example about engineering, lifestyle, the impact of invasions and leaders such as Julius Caesar.

Our trip to Bignor Roman Villa this term will enable us to learn about what a Roman villa looked like and to study the amazing mosaics that have been preserved there. We will also be focusing on how museums are organised as we prepare for setting up our own Roman Museum in school to showcase and share our learning with others in the school, and with our parents and carers at home!

As mathematicians, we will continue to develop our understanding of place value, use written methods for solving calculations, continue to learn about fractions and apply all of this within problem solving.

Our science topic in the second half of the Autumn term will ask the question, 'How do we evolve?' and in French we will be focusing on 'family'. In PSHE we will be exploring more about 'Being Me in My World', and our RE focus for this term is 'Christianity'.
