



Key Stage 1 – Year 1 and Year 2

What wiped out the Dinosaurs?

We will be enthused when reading about Dinosaurs and we will be excited to find out about what kinds of dinosaurs there were.

In literacy we will use the book Bumpus, Jumpus, Dinosaurumpus, to write character descriptions for the dinosaurs in the book. We will also use our knowledge to write information fact files.

In Science we will look at the human body and how this is different to a dinosaur.

We will then make our own dinosaur skeleton model, linked to DT.

We will learn about how Dinosaurs became extinct and make our own dinosaur song to represent what one of these creatures may have sounded like.

As readers we will read a range of dinosaur stories: we will talk about our favourite dinosaurs in the books and give reasons for our choices.

As writers we will write a character description for the dinosaurs in the books we have read. We will also use the information we have learnt to write fact files.

As mathematicians we will consider the place value of numbers, develop effective strategies for addition and subtraction, measure items in terms of length, mass and weight and name and sort 2d and 3d shapes.

As scientists we will learn about the human body and how it differs from a dinosaur. We will also look at the difference between carnivores, omnivores and herbivores.

As designers we will use our scientific knowledge to build a moving dinosaur model and make chalk dinosaur drawings.

As athletes we will develop our agility, balance and co-ordination through basic skills.
