Autumn Term Topics

Homework

PE / Games / Swimming

Weekly PE lessons for children in school or on the school field with specialist Horsham Leisurelink PE coaches, including Mr Ford, begin on Thursday 10th September. They will also be teaching specialist PE here on Thursday afternoons as part of the school's After-School PE/Sport programme throughout the academic year.

School will be up-dating parents on swimming and gymnastics in line with DFE guidance when more information is available.

Early Years Children

Emergency Contact Numbers

Please could all families make sure the school has up-to-date information on contact numbers, should there ever be an urgent matter and/or emergency arising during the school day.

School Collection

Always inform the school of any alternative arrangements for children being collected at the end of the school day, particularly at the moment when collection times are staggered.

Registration

In the event of children arriving at school after 8.55am registration and/or needing to be collected from school before the arranged collection time, parents/carers must come to the School House entrance in order to sign in/out and drop off or collect children.

Medication

All medication for children, and instructions for its use, must be given by parents to the School Office for recording and appropriate storage. School must be updated immediately please if and when circumstances/conditions change. This includes inhalers for asthma sufferers. For medical information forms please see the school's website and or contact School Office.

Injuries

Children who suffer 'minor' head injuries during the school day receive written notification from the school, on the day, for parent's information. The parents of those children are also informed by respective class teachers at the end of the day.

Coats in school

Children are required to have coats in school every day - regardless of the weather.
